

For Ice and Snow, Good Drivers Go Slow

October's storm brought only a dusting of snow to certain neighborhoods in our slice of paradise, but it also brought cold temperatures and low clouds. 'Tis the season for such inclement weather and poor road conditions.

That also means the season of crashing is upon us, but those crashes don't have to happen.

Safe drivers maintain control of their vehicles. They start and stop gradually, drive at steady speeds, gear down ahead of descents and are gentle with braking pressure.

If the vehicle does start to skid, the Colorado Department of Transportation recommends removing your foot from the accelerator or brake and steering in the direction of the skid. When the vehicle steadies itself, turn the wheels straight and proceed with caution.

These rules apply to four-wheel-drive vehicles as well as their front- or rear-wheel-drive counterparts. A 4WD vehicle doesn't stop better or faster on ice; in fact, heavier vehicles need longer stopping distances. Those eight-person urban assault vehicles require a much greater stopping distance than a hatchback.

Here are some tips for safe winter driving:

- Slow down.
- Wear your seatbelt.
- Don't use cruise control in slippery conditions.
- Remove ice and snow from windows, mirrors and lights often.
- Leave extra room between you and the vehicle you're following.
- Overpasses, canyons and curves may be extra icy. Use extra caution in these areas.
- Slow down and move to the right when emergency vehicles are approaching from the rear.
- Move over one lane to pass parked emergency vehicles and operating tow trucks.

Driving too fast, tailgating, cruising in blind spots, not paying attention and possibly even dozing at the wheel are dangerous enough on dry roads at midday; add darkness, fog or ice and we'll have a holiday recipe for disaster. Stay safe out there!

2019 Trash Service Fees

Beginning January 2019, there will be a slight increase to participate in the Pinery Trash Program. Over the past six years, trash rate increases to our residents have been modest. The last time costs were increased to Pinery residents was 2015. In recent years, the Executive Board has voted to absorb the annual percentage increase for trash removal and not to pass that expense on to our residents. Due to a significant increase in trash removal and recycling fees for 2019, the rate will increase by \$1.00 per month starting in January 2019.

Rates changes:

Quarterly: from \$64.50 to \$67.50 Yearly: from \$238 to \$250 (still includes \$20 annual discount)

All late fees and unpaid balances from prior years must be paid in 2018. Trash services will be terminated if all fees are not paid and received in the office by December 26th. Any unpaid balances will be reflected on your invoice.



Free Your Recyclables! Empty Them Loose Into Your Recycling Container

Did you know that when you bag your recyclables, all your good recycling work could be going to waste? Plastic bags wreak havoc on processing equipment and pose safety hazards to workers, so ditch them and empty your recyclables directly into your recycling container.

Recyclables should never be placed in plastic bags in your recycling carts. We have no way to know what is in them, so for safety reasons we treat all bagged material at our facilities as trash.

If you would like Waste Management to deliver trash bins to your home (at no cost), you may do so by emailing:

- Be sure to specify the size and type (trash and/or recycling) of bin you would like. You may request up to 3 bins.
- Be sure to store the containers out of view other than service day per covenants.
- Be sure to say that you are with the <u>Pinery Preferred</u> <u>Hauler program</u>.

Attention Storage Lot Lessees!

Our storage lots are currently <u>completely leased</u>. We continue to have issues with vehicles being parked in the wrong space. This is very inconvenient for lessees when they return and are unable to get into their spot. It is also very time-consuming for office staff to determine and contact the responsible person, particularly if lessee information has changed and we have not been informed of these changes.

The Pinery Homeowner

If we cannot identify the owner, we are required to have the vehicle in question impounded. It is illegal for law enforcement personnel to provide identifying information from vehicle license plates. The impound company is licensed to obtain registration and will then contact the owner of the vehicle. The owner has 30 days to respond.

The Association makes every effort to avoid impoundment, but in some situations, it is the only solution. We depend on our lessees to keep lease information current and to park in the correct space.

Some tips:

- If you see an empty space *it is not available for use*. We are full. The lessee has their vehicle out for use, repair or cleaning. If you park in a space not leased to you or in the open lot access areas, you are trespassing.
- Make sure the information on your "Exhibit A" form, of your lease, identifying your stored property is complete and current with any vehicle which might be left unattended in your space.
- If you replace your stored items, please update your form!
- Also on the Exhibit A form, make sure we have at least two current contact forms telephone and E-mail.
- Finally, KNOW your space number. Write it on your combination slip provided with your renewal, put it in your phone, or use whatever method works best for you. If you need an "Exhibit A" form to replace the current form with your lease, they are available on our website:

Douglas County Emergency Notification System—CodeRED



The system, CodeRED, is a high-speed telephone emergency notification service allowing public safety agencies the ability to deliver pre-recorded information to targeted areas within the county.

Douglas County's public safety agencies encourage everyone to register their contact information in the CodeRED system (reverse 911). Registration is not automatic, but it may be critical to your safety and that of your family.

Development Update

Filing 31 of the Timbers at the Pinery has been approved by the Douglas County Planning Commission and Board of Commissioners. Pinery resident concerns regarding traffic were discussed at both hearings. All Pinery roads are owned and maintained by the County.

Pinery residents requested a gate to limit traffic flow between neighborhoods. Traffic regulations require that all public streets be open. Access on public County roads cannot be restricted.

The Douglas County Traffic department will be looking at measures to calm traffic on Pinery roads which connect to new Timbers streets as needed.

New form 2018 w/new rate December

If you are not in the Pinery Trash Program, you might want to consider joining with the over 1500 other participating homeowners. The program offers state of the art trash service including Single Stream Recycling. This provides you, with the opportunity to put paper and other recyclables together into a labeled container (we provide the labels) of your choice. Recycling must be separated from your regular household trash, but the recycling center now separates the paper from the bottles, cans, etc. You may choose to use a container with wheels and a lid for ease of handling.

In addition, our program includes the removal of one Large or Bulk Item every month. Give Waste Management a call, set the item out with your regular household trash and say goodbye. That's twelve times a year you can get rid of a sofa bed, mattress, chair or other item without additional charges. If you have more than one item in a month low rates are offered.

1) that PHA is merely acting as a billing agent for the contracted trash service; 2) that Homeowner shall not receive any refund upon termination of Homeowner's participation in PHA trash program unless Homeowner provides advance notice to

refund upon termination of Homeowner's participation in PHA trash program unless Homeowner provides advance notice to PHA, including address to which refund should be sent; and 3) that PHA will not be liable for any act or failure to act on the part of the contracted trash service, including, without limitation, violation of laws or regulations, injury or death to persons or animals and loss or damage to property or the environment.


