

Architectural Review Committee Election – May 14, 2013

Paul Brown – Incumbent:

Since moving into The Pinery in October, 2010, Paul has wanted to give back to this community. As a new resident, he went before the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) and found the process to be very professional and open. In 2011, when he heard there was an opening on the committee, he asked for the opportunity to be part of the committee and was duly appointed.

After leaving college, Paul was a flight instructor for several years, flying numerous types of private airplanes, training people for private and commercial pilot's licenses, as well as

instrument and multi-engine ratings. He also trained future flight instructors. He then went into sales for Honeywell, and for the last 26 years has designed and sold commercial security systems and industrial control systems to governments, Fortune 500 companies, as well as smaller companies. Paul has worked with Fire Marshalls, city building inspection departments and contractors of all types, both in new construction as well as re-model/retrofits. Paul currently works for SimplexGrinnell, managing security design/sales in the Denver metro area.

Paul has worked as an electrician, carpenter, plumber, and all around construction person.
Through his service on the ARC, Paul was appointed to the Pinery Executive Board and recently, elected Board President.

Keebum Chang and Uta

Dierker: When we moved to Colorado in the beginning of 2003 with our two boys, we were drawn to the Pinery with its open spaces, many trees and wildlife and the unique homes with gardens larger than the size of a stamp. In fact, we loved it so much that a few years ago we bought another house in the Pinery for Keebum's parents to move from Korea to live here as well!

Since we moved here more than 10 years ago, we have tack-

led many remodel projects, including an addition that Keebum built himself and major landscaping done by Uta. Our home improvement projects gave us many opportunities to interact with our Architectural Review Committee (ARC) and we think it is time to give back and help in our community.

Keebum is a civil and environmental engineer. Uta is an electrical engineer. Before we moved to the Pinery, Keebum oversaw the construction of residential and light commercial developments in Kansas City while we also restored our pre-World War II house. These days we run our own environmental consulting business, mainly assisting Korean conglomerates work with North American firms that can bring better environmental clean-up technology to Korea. When we don't work in our business, on our house or in our yard, we enjoy the outdoors, either hiking, biking, skiing or snowshoeing - or just relaxing in the yard or catching up with our neighbors. With family and business on other continents, we travel relatively often.

Jess Martinez: I moved to Colorado from California in 2012 with my family and was fortunate to find a perfect home in the Pinery. We immediately fell in love with the unique landscape of the Pinery and the Colorado mountain feel. I looked for a home that was ready to go but could keep me busy with updating and small remodeling projects for the next few years. I have had experience completing small and large home improvement projects. My largest project was a 400 sq. foot addition, to include two master baths and a walk-in closet, onto our former home.

Our interaction with the ARC was a positive one when, prior to our arrival, we applied to install a split rail fence around a portion of our property. I feel that my experience with my own projects and my willingness to learn will be an asset to the Architectural Review Committee I look forward to serving on the ARC and helping in any way I can to preserve the integrity of the Pinery as a wonderful place to live for our family and future families.

Litter and *The Pinery* Environment 2

Well, I'm still at it, picking up the empty bottles, plastic bags, and other bits of junk thrown from the car windows, still doing my bit to keep The Pinery looking good. I've learned not to be too surprised at what I find.



Today, lying next to three beer bottles, was a sad and very upsetting sight: the crumpled body of a mature deer. Whoever hit it drove off and left the dying deer by the North Pinery Parkway roadside.

Once I collected myself and contacted the appropriate department in Douglas County, I felt a strong vindication of the letter I wrote yesterday to Douglas County, posing two questions:

- 1. Can we please have more signs that threaten litterers with a \$1000 fine? And,
- 2. Can we please have some well-placed signs that warn drivers of deer crossing our Pinery roads?

I'll let you know what response I get.

On a more positive note, I see the signs of spring, especially in the dry earth that surrounds my house. Green shoots have pushed their way through the soil crust, buds are appearing on my cherry tree, and the red-winged blackbirds and magpies, talking their heads off, give me a joyful, celebratory morning greeting each day as I leave my home, empty plastic bag in hand, off to pick up trash.







As I walk, my eyes are alert, open wide, and not just for soda cans. The other day I picked up a couple of dead ponderosa pine branches, peeled off the bark, and saw the winding trails of bark beetle larvae. The teacher in me took over and I collected twigs with the best, most intricate, patterns to take home, soak in soapy water, and sandpaper the ends when they are dry. Why? To enhance the tracks and trails made by the larvae as they eat their way through the tree inner wood. Why? To show kids, of course, in the nearby primary school, just how a tiny beetle brings about the demise of those Pinery trees stressed and suffering from the persistent drought and the poor Pinery soil.

As the daytime temperatures increase, it won't be long now before I'll spot spiders, beetles, and other small creatures, lurking in and around the grasses and plants that make up the wild, beautiful Pinery environment. I can't wait for that magical feeling when I see my first large wolf spider of the year! OK, time for my afternoon litter-picking walk. If I'm really lucky, I might come across......well, I'll keep you posted. Where's my KingSoopers bag?





Douglas County Household Chemical Roundups 9 a.m.—3 p.m.

Open to residents of Douglas County

Acceptable Items: paint and paint products, motor oil, antifreeze, rechargeable batteries, vehicle batteries, house and garden chemicals, pool chemicals, fluorescent light bulbs, CFLs, fire extinguishers, fireworks, ammunition, items containing mercury, propane tanks, and pickup truck tires only (remove from rim).

<u>Unacceptable Items</u>: business and commercial waste, radioactive waste, smoke detectors, scrap metal, oil drums, asbestos, explosives stronger than fireworks, or any compressed gases other than propane.

You will need: a driver's license, water bill, utility bill or phone bill as proof of residency.

<u>Cost</u>: A contribution of \$25 per vehicle is appreciated to help offset the high cost of hazardous waste disposal.

Paint: Although leftover latex paint will be accepted at the Roundups, water-based latex paint can be safely and legally disposed of in regular household garbage if it is completely dried out. Mixing the paint with kitty litter, sand, dirt or concrete-mix will help speed the drying process. Leave the lids off of all paint cans so that waste haulers can see that the paint can is empty or that the paint is completely dry.

PHA Trash Program Enrollment Form

If you are not in the Pinery Trash Program, you might want to consider joining with the over 1500 other participating homeowners. The program offers state of the art trash service including Single Stream Recycling. This provides you, with the opportunity to put paper and other recyclables together into a labeled container (we provide the labels) of your choice. Recycling must be separated from your regular household trash, but the recycling center now separates the paper from the bottles, cans, etc. You may choose to use a container with wheels and a lid for ease of handling.

In addition, our program includes the removal of one Large or Bulk Item every month. Give Waste Management a call, set the item out with your regular household trash and say goodbye. That's twelve times a year you can get rid of a sofa bed, mattress, chair or other item without additional charges. If you have more than one item in a month low rates are offered.

AGREEMENT

By submitting this enrollment form with initial payment, the above Pinery resident and/or homeowner ("Homeowner") hereby authorizes The Pinery Homeowners' Association, Inc. ("PHA") to engage its contracted trash service to collect and dispose of Homeowner's normal household waste materials at the above described Pinery residence. Homeowner warrants that all waste materials offered for collection will not contain any hazardous, toxic or radioactive wastes or substances as defined by applicable federal, state or local laws or regulations. Homeowner agrees to pay PHA in advance within 15 days of billing for trash service at the PHA's then current rates until such time as Homeowner notifies PHA of Homeowner's termination from the PHA trash program. Failure to pay as specified which results in rebilling and/or termination will incur fees to cover the PHA cost of these actions. Homeowner shall be solely responsible to the contracted trash service for any additional services requested which are not included in PHA's normal trash program. Homeowner acknowledges and agrees:

1) that PHA is merely acting as a billing agent for the contracted trash service; 2) that Homeowner shall not receive any refund upon termination of Homeowner's participation in PHA trash program unless Homeowner provides advance notice to PHA, including address to which refund should be sent; and 3) that PHA will not be liable for any act or failure to act on the part of the contracted trash service, including, without limitation, violation of laws or regulations, injury or death to persons or animals and loss or damage to property or the environment.
