The Pinery Water and Wastewater District is beginning construction on a two million gallon potable water storage tank. This tank will provide improved reliability and more storage for fire flow situation to the surrounding community. The new tank is being constructed on the north side of North Pinery Parkway just past Windwood Way (if you are headed into the Pinery). Glacier Construction is the general contractor on this project and were mobilizing to begin construction the last week in October. Construction is scheduled to extend to July 2015. ## **COVENANT CORNER** The Pinery Architectural Review Committee



#### Deck Changes / Replacements

With the age of many homes in the Pinery, a common exterior project is replacement of an existing deck. If a previously-approved deck is being replaced with no change in size, shape or materials (including railing), the project is considered maintenance or restoration and submittal for Architectural Review is not required. If changes are part of the plan or for example a cover is to be added, submittal is needed.

Start by taking photos of the existing deck, at a distance, so that a good perspective of the deck and it's relation to the house and property can be understood.

Additionally, a Douglas County Building Permit is required in most cases. The County requires railings spaced so that a 4" sphere cannot pass through. For ground level decks, stairs with over 4 risers require railings.

Submittal for architectural review should include at minimum:

 Plot plan for property showing
Location of existing dwelling

- Location of property lines and easements
- Location of proposed deck
- Measurements between all of the above
- Drawing of proposed deck showing all finished elevations and dimensions (front, back, sides and overhead) with materials and colors (finish) indicated or supplied, roof pitch indicated if roofing is being added. In some filings, Covenants require 4/12 minimum roof pitch.
- Location and description of any added lighting.
- Photos of current structure and the location of the deck.
- Signatures of affected neighbors to indicate that they are aware of the proposed change or addition, the meeting date, and time the plan will be presented to the ARC.



# Bayou Gulch Connector Trail open to the public for non-motorized use

A new 4-mile soft-surface trail has been completed on Bayou Gulch Open Space and is now open to the public for nonmotorized use. Parking is available at Bayou Gulch Regional Park at 4815 Fox Sparrow Road, Parker, CO 80134. A connection to the new trail is on the west side of Bayou Gulch Regional Parks, and crosses Bayou Gulch Road at a cross-walk with a self

-activated light to stop traffic. The trail around the edge of the open space is open to pedestrians and equestrians only. The connector that runs west under highway 83 to the Cherry Creek Regional Trail is open to pedestrians, equestrians, and bicyclists. The peripheral trail may be closed from time to time to accommodate equestrian events of the Colorado Horse Park; the connector trail will remain open at all times. The horse jumps and the pathways leading to the jumps are the private property of the Colorado Horse Park and are not open to the public. # PHA Trash Program Enrollment Form

If you are not in the Pinery Trash Program, you might want to consider joining with the over 1500 other participating homeowners. The program offers state of the art trash service including Single Stream Recycling. This provides you, with the opportunity to put paper and other recyclables together into a labeled container (we provide the labels) of your choice. Recycling must be separated from your regular household trash, but the recycling center now separates the paper from the bottles, cans, etc. You may choose to use a container with wheels and a lid for ease of handling. In addition, our program includes the removal of one Large or Bulk Item every month. Give Waste Management a call, set the item out with your regular household trash and say goodbye. That's twelve times a year you can get rid of a sofa bed, mattress, chair or other item without additional charges. If you have more than one item in a month low rates are offered.

All trash starts must be received in the PHA office no later than 1 p.m. on the Thursday prior to the desired Monday service day.


#### AGREEMENT

By submitting this enrollment form with initial payment, the above Pinery resident and/or homeowner ("Homeowner") hereby authorizes The Pinery Homeowners' Association, Inc. ("PHA") to engage its contracted trash service to collect and dispose of Homeowner's normal household waste materials at the above described Pinery residence. Homeowner warrants that all waste materials offered for collection will not contain any hazardous, toxic or radioactive wastes or substances as defined by applicable federal, state or local laws or regulations. Homeowner agrees to pay PHA in advance within 15 days of billing for trash service at the PHA's then current rates until such time as Homeowner notifies PHA of Homeowner's termination from the PHA trash program. Failure to pay as specified which results in rebilling and/or termination will incur fees to cover the PHA cost of these actions. Homeowner shall be solely responsible to the contracted trash service for any additional services requested which are not included in PHA's normal trash program. Homeowner shall not receive any refund upon termination of Homeowner's participation in PHA trash program unless Homeowner provides advance notice to PHA, including address to which refund should be sent; and 3) that PHA will not be liable for any act or failure to act on the part of the contracted trash service, including, without limitation, violation of laws or regulations, injury or death to persons or animals and loss or damage to property or the environment.


